Synopsis From the Constitution and By-Laws of The Saint Andrew’s Society of Vermont

Membership shall be open to all Scots, or lineal descendants of natives of Scotland, or members of the immediate family of same, who are of good moral character.. The classes of membership shall be: Regular Member, Junior Member, Life Member, and Honorary Member. A Family membership shall consist of both spouses and all children under the age of 18. Both spouses are Regular Members. Children under 18 are Junior Members and shall not vote or hold office.

Any Regular Member may become a Life Member upon a lump-sum payment of twenty (20) times the current dues and thereafter is exempt from annual dues. Honorary Member is a Member who has been exempt from all dues for service to the Society and elected to that honor as provided below. By Merit: Honorary membership may be conferred upon a member who has manifested unusual or exemplary service to the Society. Nomination may be made by a unanimous vote of the Board of Managers or by a petition signed by not less than twenty members in good standing and submitted through the Board of Managers. Such conferral requires a three fourths vote of all members present at a properly warned meeting. By Age and Service: After attaining the age of seventy-five years a member with twenty (20) years of membership in good standing may be made an Honorary Member by a majority vote of the Board of Managers without fee.
